Through an array of measures, it works to help differently abled children and women to lead a normal life by providing services like early identification, intervention, education, vocational training, employment opportunities and aids and assistive devices etc. By sponsoring education and by providing vocational training, it works to open opportunities for differently abled and marginalized children and women. Zwilling Foundation India at present works with 64 children and around 33 women and is aspiring to include more vocational training programs and reach out to the needy. Zwilling also undertakes many other one time projects.

In the year 2022- 23, Zwilling Foundation India has stepped up its pace in reaching out to the differently abled. We are happy to share that word of mouth is spreading about our activities and new beneficiaries are constantly approaching us for support. All this is because of the dedicated efforts of our Staff, under the managerial supervision of Ms Divya. A very special mention to Ms Lalitha for coordinating seamlessly at all levels. Much appreciation to Ms Lempa Gaberial for all her efforts in coordinating with us from Germany.

During the year 2022-23, We have successfully executed about 69 projects. We were able to extend our support to 31 persons with assistive devices, 29 Livelihood programs ensured food on the plate to about 120 individuals, 23 New Trainees in an inclusive tailoring batch were started, God Children total number- 64, Open self-programs conducted were 8, Community Projects -11, benefitting about 2000 people Education sponsorships – 6.

During this year through our various programs, we have touched about 2000+ lives. This is a strong motivation to us as we wish to extend our reach wider. We extend our gratitude to Mr Sambasiva Rao, our Managing Trustee, and Dr. Erich Schiffers of The Werhahn Group of Companies, for their constant guidance and their faith in us.

We also thank Tweezerman India Private Limited, Ital Beauty Nippers India Private Limited, The Werhahn Family, the Zwilling Group of companies, and Zwilling Kitchen India Private Limited for their continued support.



OVERVIEW OF THE YEAR 2021-2022

SKILL TRAINING - TAILORING

From April 2022 to March 2023, we trained a total of 33 women, including 23 women in tailoring skill development and 10 candidates in culinary and baking skill development courses. In the tailoring batch of 2022-23, a total of 23 candidates were taught, with 83% of the candidates being differently abled. A total of 293 candidates have been trained in different skills as of March 2023.

WORKSHOPS

Bakery Class for the Marginalised Women : The cookies and cupcake baking workshop was held at Zwilling Foundation India on April 4th 2022. After receiving the training, three of the ladies started their own businesses selling cookies and cakes in their neighborhood.

OTHER EVENTS IN SKILL TRAINING

Jobwork Order in Training Section: Various job work orders were received and completed on schedule, and the customers were pleased to receive the finished products. They conveyed their satisfaction, which was very encouraging.

One-day Picnic for Trainees: On July 2nd, we have planned a one-day picnic for all of our trainees and contract staff. Churches and temples in Velanganni and Thirunallar were visited during the day.

Ayudha Pooja & Pongal Celebration: Various festivals are celebrated at the Foundation, where we share the significance of various festivals and cultural values. On October 2022 Ayudha Pooja was celebrated and gifts were distributed to all. During this time all the trainees visited a handicrafts exhibition, giving them exposure to various handmade products.

New Tailoring Batch for the year 2022-2023: In June 2022, a new inclusive batch of twenty tailoring trainees was begun, comprising 12 differently abled individuals and 8 regular candidates. The training is being held as a full-day event. The foundation provided the participants with refreshments, lunch, training materials, and transportation to and from the foundation.

World Disability Day : We celebrated World Disability Day on December 3rd 2022. Throughout the day, there were several games and activities planned specifically for the trainees, making it thoroughly enjoyable. Following that, the ladies greatly benefited from a counselling session led by Dr. Vidhya Ramkumar, Chairperson, Dowry Prohibition Advisory Board, Government of Puducherry. The session was extremely empowering, emphasis was for women to stand up for their rights, not to be victimised and to support one another in times of crises.



God children Project – Educational Sponsorship

The God child program supports differently abled children for their educational and medical interventions. In 2022-2023, we have a total strength of 64 children supported under this project.



Birthday Celebration: Birthday Celebration of the Godchildren is done during the last week of every month. The children are given age-appropriate gifts, and a cake-cutting is done for all 64 of them during the year. It's amazing to see each child's face light up when they receive their gifts.



Supported Speech Therapy The speech therapy for Abdul Kadar is being given in Nova, Hearing Aids & Speech Therapy Clinic, Puducherry. He is being supported for his speech therapy from June 2022 and he has improved in his communication and understanding capability.

Provided Health Supplements: Health supplements were provided to Godchild Sriram from the month of June 2022 for his betterment. He was provided with health supplements like sprouts health mix, energy drinks, lentils, dates, etc for his physical improvement. His improvement was being assessed once in three months and his health is being monitored by the staff regularly.



Orientation and Awareness Program: For the Godchildren in their adolescence, we held an orientation and awareness program. The program's major goal was to teach children how to navigate this stage of life and choose a better path.





Excellence in Sports & Athletic Events: The Godchild Anraj Narasimman has participated in many national-level athletic events in the year 2022-2023 and bagged many prizes. He has participated in national-level athletic events conducted in Madhya Pradesh and bagged a bronze medal. He was honored by the Chief Minister of Puducherry for his excellence in sports.



Summer camp: Summer camp was organized to help the godchildren make the most of their summer vacation. The program was scheduled to run for two weeks, from May 16th to May 26th, 2022. The children's participation in summer camp has demonstrated their enthusiasm.





Excellence in Science Exhibition: The Godchildren studying in Sri Pachayappane Special School for the Hearing Impaired has participated in the science exhibition conducted by the school and exhibited their talent in September 2022.



- Four new children were assigned with Godparents for the year 2022-23 in the month of May 2022. Eleven new childrens were identified and assessed for the Godchildren Project in the year 2022-23.




- In November 2022, the God children are spending time at Foundation making handmade gifts to express their love and affection to their Godparents in the form of Christmas greeting cards and gifts.
- Parents meeting for the Godchildren parents has been conducted on 2nd November 2022 following which a Parents counseling session on how to handle the children in different scenarios was organized on 18th November 2022.
- The Godchildren studying in Pachayappane hearing-impaired school have participated in the Kalainjan program a talent showcase program for the disabled and won the competition.
- The Christmas celebration in December 2022 will be remembered for the special performances that were put on and the gifts that all the Godchildren received. The visitors' presence, together with that of Dr. Erich Schiffers, was a memorable Christmas party.
- Parents meeting for the Godchildren Reserve Project has been conducted on 21st December 2022 to discuss the future educational plans for the children who are attaining 18 years of age in the next financial year.
- Christmas and new year gifts were made by the Godchildren and were sent to Germany for the distribution to the sponsors.





Livelihood Program

The livelihood program has supported thirty-one women in total, twenty-six women as piece rate workers and 5 candidate as outsourcing for the job work. At present we support 10 members in the livelihood program out of which 8 are differently abled and 2 are normal. In 2022-2023 , a new product Black Pouch has been developed and the bulk production has been dispatched this year. We have taken some garments orders to the customers and guests to the foundation. The total quantity of materials dispatched from Zwilling Foundation India is given for reference.






Projects
