Zwilling Foundation India, an initiative taken by the Werhahn Group of Companies, Germany and Mr.R.Sambasiva Rao, India. It was founded as a Public Charitable Trust Act in 2011. Through an array of measures, it works to help differently abled children and women to lead a normal life by providing services like early identification, intervention, education, vocational training, employment opportunities and aids and assistive devices etc. By sponsoring education and by providing vocational training, it works to open opportunities for differently abled and marginalized children and women. Zwilling Foundation India at present works with 69 children and around 73 women and is aspiring to include more vocational training programs and reach out to the needy. Zwilling Foundation India also undertakes many other one-time community and livelihood projects.

Making Corporate social responsibility more meaningful Our mission to empower the differently abled and marginalized women, through skill training, we enter our 13th year in reaching out to the differently abled population. This year Zwilling Foundation India has touched about 5500 lives through our various programs.

Our God child project stands with ongoing support to 64 children for their educational and medical needs. Some of our Children and adults have movement restrictions, for which Zwilling Foundation has employed an inhouse physiotherapist, who also does home visits, for those who are unable to come to the Foundation. Dr. Ahamed Aarif intervention has shown amazing improvements improving the agility and mobility of children and adults alike. This year we extended our support in skill training to about 25 young ladies of an orphanage and an enthusiastic boy who were very motivated to learn tailoring, they have successfully completed their course, and feel confident to stitch their own garments.

After the training program in tailoring Zwilling Foundation gives its trainees an opportunity to experience employability. Our Trainees stitch various products as requested from our other sister concerns and are doing very well. This year we had 23 inhouse trainees and 58 outsourcing team handling job- work under our Livelihood project creating an Inclusive work environment.

We are Happy to share that During the Year 2023-24 we have seen that the number of projects has increased. We have been able to reach out to a lot more beneficiaries mainly through our livelihood project where we encourage and support entrepreneurs in living a life of dignity. Our emphasis is to make sure that the Foundation can support as many differently abled, families as possible for their livelihood.

With The support of Mr. Rui Santos Our community project at Nesal Village alone has impacted about 5000 lives, providing them with portable water which has come as a big relief to the nearby villagers too. The Women are much grateful as they no longer have to travel miles to fetch drinking water. We Thank Mr. Rui Santos for his generous Donation.

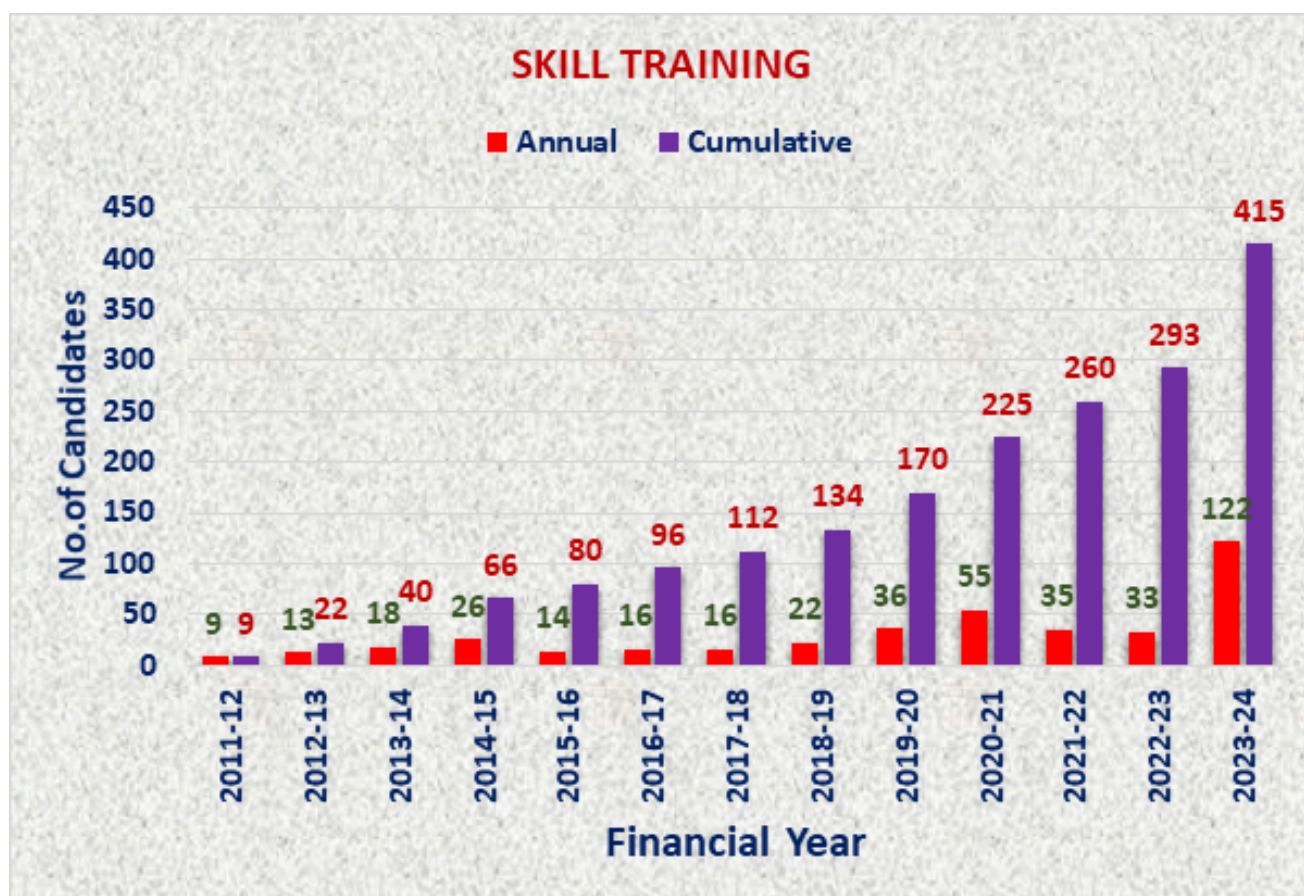

OVERVIEW OF THE YEAR 2023-2024

SKILL TRAINING

From April 2023 to March 2024, we trained a total of 122 candidates, including 106 women and 16 male candidates in various skill development program like tailoring, basic computer courses and in culinary and baking. In the in-house tailoring batch of 2023-24, a total of 44 candidates were taught, with 76% of the candidates being differently abled. An outreach program in Vudhavi Karangal orphanage has accommodated 26 candidates with 25 girls and 1 boy. We have conducted basic computer training for 12 visually challenged candidates. Basic computer skills were taught to 28 candidates. A total of 415 candidates have been trained in different skills as of March 2024.



Zwilling Foundation India has taken the next step towards its skill training in teaching Computer Course to the marginalized students of society. The course has been started in April 2023 and it was in full swing till the month of June 2023. Approximately 30 candidates attended the course and MS Office were taught to them. We thank Dr. Erich Schiffrers for donating computers to the Foundation which enabled us to take classes at the earliest possible.



In May 2023, we had new candidates in the tailoring training program under Part-time classes along with the full time candidates. All the candidates were school students in their 10th to 12th standards who are eager to learn a new skill in a short duration of time. The short term crash course to make their own garment was taught to all and periodic assessments were done.

Outreach Program : Zwilling Foundation India has taken its next leap towards starting the skill training program for the young girls of the Vudhavi Karangal Home in TN Palayam, Puducherry. Vudhavi Karangal Home is an orphanage that accommodates orphans and semi orphans in their home. A trainer has been appointed by Zwilling Foundation India to teach the skill training program. This program has been started on June 2023 and its progress is followed Zwilling Foundation India. This is a 1 year program which concludes on April 2024.

Computer Skill Training for the Visually Challenged Candidates: In July 2023, Zwilling Foundation extended its computer skill training program to help visually challenged candidates in association with Puducherry Corporation for the development of women and differently-abled persons Ltd. The skill training was led by Mr. C. Kannan, the trainer. The candidates who have been involved in the program are with partial or profound loss of sight and they were well-disciplined and highly interested in taking their classes. We hope that the skill training would be an added advantage for them to fetch employability.

Culinary and Baking: Zwilling Foundation India has resumed the cookie baking class once again for the welfare of the marginalized women who were interested in baking. The one-week program was conducted for 12 ladies who belong to different parts of the Puducherry and Tamilnadu.

One-day trip to Yercaud: The trainees had a great time during their one-day trip to Yercaud! Taking employees on outings like this can be a fantastic way to boost morale and build team spirit. It's wonderful that they all enjoyed the new experience and had a fun-filled day together. Such outings can help foster positive relationships among colleagues and create lasting memories.

Ayudha Pooja & Pongal Celebration: We share the significance of various festivals and cultural values. On October 2023 Ayudha Pooja was celebrated and gifts were distributed to all. On January 2024, Pongal pooja was done marking the harvest festival. All were actively involved in the celebration.

Inhouse Training: Three of the trainees have been shifted to take the zwilling products as they have completed the training. Mrs.Jayanthi with 23 years of tailoring experience has joined the team as a new trainer in January 2024.

Counselling and Personality Development Program: Mrs. Bindu Modi, Trustee Zwilling Foundation India and a Clinical Psychologist by profession, led the counseling session for the trainees in November and December 2023. The session covered topics on self-discipline, anger management, healthy communication skills, and impacts of alcoholism and drug abuse. The trainees are actively participating in the session, and the counseling session is a stress reliever for all the trainees to open up.





Womens day Celebration: One of the best days of the year for all of us is Women's Day celebration. In honor of Women's Day, our trustee, Mrs. Bindu Mam, has given adorable gifts to every woman in the foundation. We have conducted fun filled games to all the ladies present in foundation

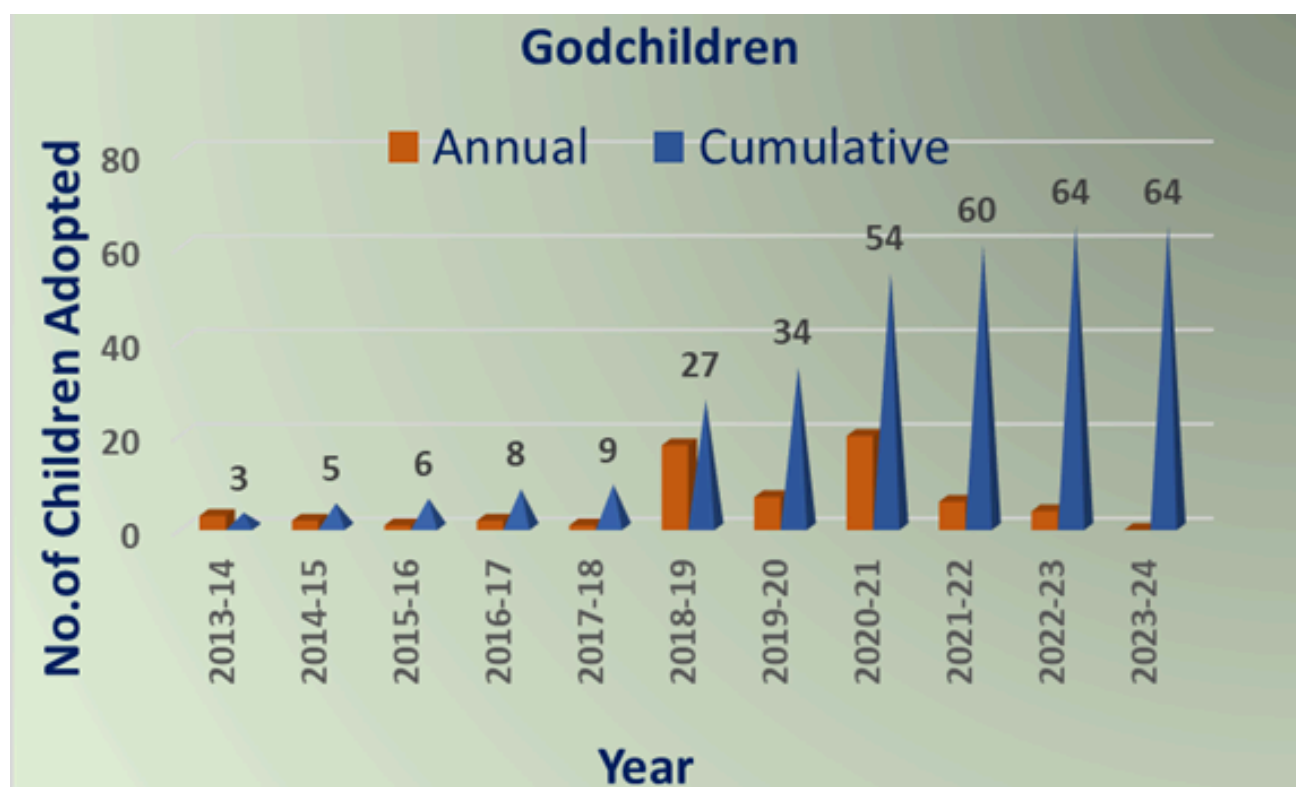

God children Project Educational Sponsorship

The God Child program supports differently abled children for their educational and medical interventions. In 2023-24, new children have not been enrolled and we continued our support to the 64 children under this project.



Birthday Celebration: The Godchildren's birthdays are celebrated during the final week of each month. Age-appropriate gifts are presented to the children, and a cake-cutting ceremony is held for each of the 64 kids. Seeing the joy on each child's face as they open their gifts is truly remarkable.





Speech Therapy : The speech therapy for Pragadeesh and Abdul Kadar is being supported throughout the year. Both the children has improved in their communication and understanding capability.

Health Supplements:

Health supplements were provided to Godchild Sriram throughout the year for his betterment. He was provided with health supplements like sprouts health mix, energy drinks, lentils, dates, etc for his physical improvement. His Improvement was being assessed once in three months.



Audiometry & Eye Camp : In April 2023, Zwilling Foundation India conducted a free eye screening camp and audiometry camp along with Jothy Eye Care, Pondicherry and Sandro Hearing Aids, Pondicherry. Almost all the Godchildren's have participated in the camp and 6 Godchildren were supported with their hearing aid.

Physiotherapy Sessions: Godchildrens were given physiotherapy sessions by visiting their home for the physical betterment. Dr.Ahamed Aarif has visited the children home personally and exercises were taught to them based on their ailment. Supportive devices for the physiotherapy treatment were also given for their improvement like spirometer, chairs, walkers etc.

Sign Language Classes: In the summer camp, sign language classes for hearing-impaired children especially for our Godchildren were arranged. The classes commenced on 2nd May 2023 and ended on 31st May 2023. The class was very much helpful to all the hearing-impaired children as they collectively got benefitted to learn a new language (American Sign Language) which was useful and helpful for communication with others. Learning Sign Language for them is considered mandatory for Hearing Impaired children for their academics also. The class was Taken by Deaf Enabled Foundation, Pondicherry.

Godchildren Christmas Celebration: We conducted a Christmas event in December during Dr.Erich Schiffer's visit to the foundation. During the Christmas season, we had celebrations, dancing performances, interactions with the children, and plenty of fun. All of the children were overjoyed to get their Christmas presents. The Christmas party was graced by Dr.Erich Schiffers, Mr.Sambasiva Rao and Mrs.Bindu Modi along with the staff and trainees.

Achievements: Many of our Godchildren have participated in sports and other competitions and excelled in their activities. Many of them have grabbed many prizes in the competitions they have participated.

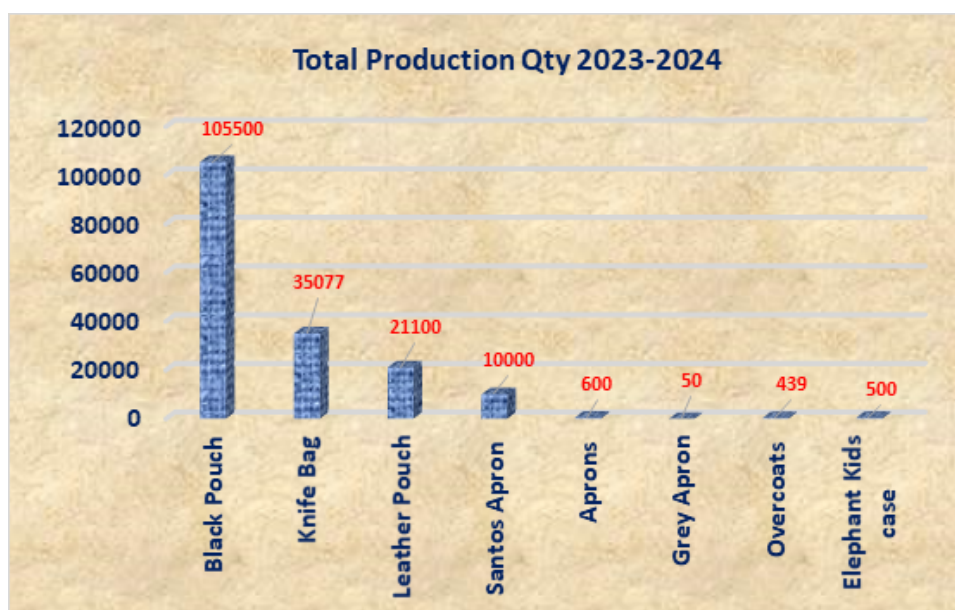

Livelihood Program

The livelihood program has supported around 81 women in total, twenty-three women as in-house piece rate workers, and fifty-eight candidates as outsourcing the job work. At present, we support 15 members in the livelihood program out of which 11 are differently abled and 4 are normal. In 2023-2024, two new products Knife Bag and Santos Barbecue Apron have been developed and bulk production has been dispatched this year. We have taken some garment orders to the customers and guests to the foundation. The total quantity of materials dispatched from Zwilling Foundation India is given for reference.





Other Projects

Many more projects were initiated by the team Zwilling foundation India in and around Pondicherry and Tamilnadu in the year 2023-2024. Seventy-seven projects were initiated and over 5400 beneficiaries have been supported in different categories of support such as Livelihood, Community, Aids & Assistive devices, Education Sponsorship and Skill training.

Livelihood Projects

The Zwilling Foundation India initiated 39 livelihood projects in various parts of Puducherry and Tamil Nadu. Through these initiatives, the foundation is probably having a big influence on the communities in which it works by helping people and their families. Initiatives aimed at enabling people to support themselves and enhance their quality of life are considered vital and concentrate on topics like revenue generation and entrepreneurship. Through these projects, people are given the tools and opportunities they require to become self-sufficient and elevate their socioeconomic status.

Community Projects

The local communities have benefited greatly from the help that Zwilling Foundation India has given to almost 1630 people through its nine community initiatives in Puducherry and Tamil Nadu's villages and schools. The foundation has provided educational resources, infrastructural development, and other support to schools in these areas.

The community initiatives in Puducherry and Tamil Nadu had a long-lasting positive effect on the villages and schools. The beneficiaries and the region's general socio-economic growth and improvement have benefited from the foundation's efforts. Providing schoolchildren with clean drinking water, and infrastructure support like fans, lights boards, etc to enhance their well-being was the major contribution this year. Zwilling Foundation India was a part of the winning cricket team's experience by helping to cover their transportation costs.



The Parasitting Cricket Association, Villianur Pondicherry has requested the Managing Trustee to support them to attend the 2nd National Level Sitting Cricket Tournament (PSCL 2023) in Chennai where 5 teams from all over India were participating. They have won in 2nd Place making the other teams down. The team was supported with their transport expense and the sports equipment as per their request by Zwilling Foundation India.



Openshelf : We initiated an open-shelf program in 2018 where extra clothing and household goods were gathered and decently displayed for the underprivileged and destitute people to take. This is being carried out every month in the nearby and isolated villages around the foundation.





Aids & Assistive Devices Projects

Zwilling Foundation India helped 29 people with disabilities by giving them wheelchairs, walkers, tricycles, hearing aids, calipers, and other assistive equipment. People with impairments can be much more independent and mobile using these technologies, making it easier for them to move around and participate in different activities. The foundation's initiatives are to aid people in recovering from their illnesses and to encourage independence to build a more diverse society in which everyone has an equal chance to prosper.

Physiotherapy Sessions:

Zwilling Foundation India has initiated to provide physiotherapy sessions to the Locomotor disabled candidates in the Foundation who have approached us for their betterment. Continuous therapy will make them feel better and the candidates are continuously attending the sessions and their utmost efforts are showing tremendous improvements. Dr.Ahamed Aarif is the backbone of this physiotherapy session. On all 6 days of the week from 2 Pm to 5 Pm, the physiotherapy sessions are taking place in the foundation. We have enabled house visits for the patients and for the Godchildren who were unable to reach the foundation which was very helpful and more candidates benefitted through the physiotherapy sessions.

From the year 2019, many beneficiaries have benefitted from this scheme. We have supported 21 candidates till the year 2023-2024.

2019-2020: In the year 2019, higher education was sponsored for 6 children from Satya School. They got admission for Vocational training in Vivekananda Rural Community College. They could not afford to pay the fees and at that time, Zwilling Foundation India stepped in and helped them through this award. All 6 have completed their education and have become financially independent.

2020-2021 : Four outstanding Government School children were chosen by conducting tests and awarded cash prizes.

2021-2022 : Education was sponsored for 5 intellectually challenged boys and they were all placed successfully.

2022-2023 : Four projects under different categories were considered and all four candidates has been supported with their requirement as per their request.

The two candidates have not secured their ranks in their entrance exam, this gave the two children of the restricted group an opportunity to learn more about what NEET coaching entails.

We have received a donation from Mr. Rui Santos, a friend of Dr. Erich Schiffers to be utilized for supporting community projects. We implemented one community initiative in December 2023. We established a purified drinking water system with a capacity of 2000 liters per hour for the people of Nesal Village, Tamilnadu, and the surrounding villages. We take this opportunity to thank Mr. Rui Santos for his donation. Around 3500 people benefit from this community project, and residents of four remote villages, including Nesal, Vilvanatham, Aprampattu, and Kodur, get their drinking water from the plant established by the Zwilling Foundation India.





Other Events

Eye Camp : On April 2023, Zwilling Foundation India has conducted a free eye screening camp along with Jothy Eye Care, Pondicherry. Eight technicians and foundation personnel worked at the camp, and nearly 120 individuals went through the basic screening before being referred to the hospital for the next step. Participants in the camp include trainees, staff, Godchildren, and people from the foundation's surrounding areas.

Audiometry Camp: Zwilling Foundation India, in collaboration with Sandro Hearing Aids, Pondicherry, held an audiometry camp on 25th April 2023. At the camp, two technicians conducted the audiometry examination for approximately 65 people with some of them being referred to the hospital for the next phase. Trainees, staff, Godchildren, and people from the foundation's surrounding areas are among those that attend the camp.



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Field Visit : A team of 16 candidates and 3 staff from Sri Vivekananda Rural Community College has visited the tailoring skill development section of Zwilling Foundation India for their exposure to making fine quality materials. The interaction with the team was helpful on both ends and knowledge sharing on the quality production is given to the candidates.

With each session, he displayed remarkable dedication and perseverance and with the support of a walker, he gradually gained the confidence to take his first steps towards independence. Today, Sathish stands tall as a shining example of what can be achieved with perseverance and support. Sathish's journey serves as a testament to the power of determination and the boundless possibilities that lie within each of us.

Vijayaragavan's Triumph: From Adversity to Achievement

In May 2023, with the intervention of Zwilling Foundation India, Nishanth was offered to pursue a Diploma course in Animation at Swami Vivekananda Rural Community College. With the Foundation's sponsorship covering his course and hostel fees, his hard work paid off when he secured a placement at Shiva Graphics in Pondicherry, with an impressive stipend of Rs. 6000 per month. Nishanth's success not only highlights his personal triumph but also underscores the transformative power of skill development in enabling independence and empowerment. We are immensely proud of Nishanth and look forward to witnessing his continued success and growth.

Karthiga's Empowerment: From Learner to Entrepreneur

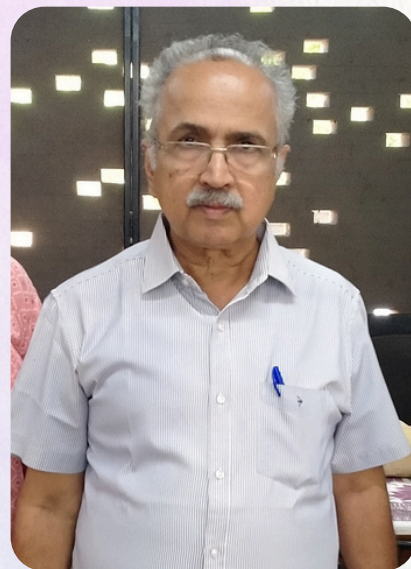

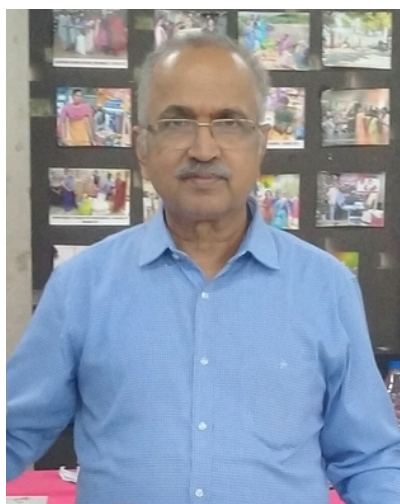
